Saturday, January 12th 2019 from 4:30 – 7:00 p.m

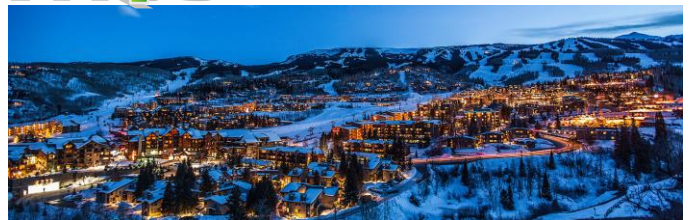
